PRIMER FILLER GUIDE



Ensure surface is clean and dry.

Sand areas adjacent to repairs using P240-320 Grit Dry.



Use Maroon Scourer Pad to scuff the gloss off of areas that are hard to sand.

Use Wax and Grease Remover to clean the surface in wipe-on/ wipe-off method.

Mix Primer Filler with appropriate Thinners or Hardeners in the recommended ratio.

A 1.8mm-2.0mm Spray Gun is recommended.



Apply a light first coat over the repair area.



Allow 3-5 minutes to flash off dry.

It is recommended that the first coat is the furtherest distance out. Each coat after should be stepped in each time so there isn't a large build up on the edge of the primed area.



Allow sufficient drying time (usually 5-7 hours) for primer to cure.

Apply a contrasting colour mist quide coat such as black before sanding.




Initial sand with P400 Grit Wet or P240-320 Grit Dry.



Final sand with P800-1200 Grit Wet or P500-800 Grit Dry.
